### **Narrative**

All requirements are clearly articulated in the undergraduate catalog for Albany State University. The most recent version is 2004-2007 [\[1\]](#). The catalog is divided into the following sections. The sections are Mission, History and Profile of the university, Admissions, Financial Information, Student Affairs services, Academic Information, Academic Affairs Requirements/Regulations and Support Services and Special Programs.

The Core Curriculum is delineated in each of the Programs of Study followed by the listing of each college. The Colleges identified in the catalog are the College of Arts and Sciences, College of Business, College of Education, College of Health Professions. The new catalog will reflect the new structural changes to the Colleges, i.e. the College of Arts and Sciences will be changed to the College of Arts and Humanities; and the College of Health Professions will be changed to the College of Sciences and Health Professions. The degree requirements for each major are still intact within the catalog even though a re-alignment with the colleges has taking place. The details of the re-alignment were sent to SACS upon Board of Regents approval [\[2\]](#).

Each college speaks to general graduation requirements, grading, and special concerns related to certification within the college. A course description is provided to each course available to the student by major. New courses approved by the university faculty will be included in the new catalog. University and Board of Regents personnel information is provided in the final section of the catalog.

All students are provided a hard copy or electronic copy of the course syllabus for each class.
