Title IV of the Higher Education Act (HEA) governs the federal student financial aid programs. The University maintains an agreement, Program Participation Agreement [1], and a copy of the Eligibility and Certification Approval Report [2] to document compliance with Title IV of the 1998 Higher Education Act Amendments. As of this date, Albany State University is not aware of any reported violations regarding the institutions ability and capability to provide student financial aid under Title IV of the Higher Education Act. According to the Fiscal Year 2006 audit report conducted by the State of Georgia Department of Audits and Accounts of Audits [3], all prior year findings related to disbursement of student financial aid have been resolved.
